## **DOING BUSINESS AT HOME**

- 1. The Town of Virgin encourages residents to work from home. Virgin ordinances require that you have a "Home Occupation License" before your home may be used for business purposes. If you intend to do business or allow someone else to do business from your home, you must submit an application to the Town Clerk and pay a small fee to get an official to Home Occupation License along with your Business License.
- 2. If the answer to all of the following questions is no, you are exempt, which means you may operate as soon as you receive your Business License, and do not need a Home Occupation permit for your home business. If you answer yes to any one of them, you will need to apply for a Home Occupation Permit and receive approval and any conditions placed on the use before you may begin to do business.

## Do I need a permit for my home business?

- Will your business be conducted where it may be visible from property boundaries?
- Will your business be required by law to collect sales, use, service, resort, or bed taxes?
- Will your business employ non-occupant workers (anyone who does not live in your home)?
- Will your business receive customers, clients, or business-related salespeople on the premises?
- Will your business generate any more noise, light, dust, odors, pests, hazardous materials, or visible storage of supplies, merchandise, or equipment than an ordinary home does?

If you have any trouble deciding whether you need a license or permit, please let the Clerk know.
